Aristotle considered these six things to be essential to good drama: • Plot: This is what happens in the play. Plot refers to the action; the basic storyline of the play. • Theme: While plot refers to the action of the play, theme refers to the meaning of the play. Theme is the main idea or lesson to be learned from the play.

Elements Of Drama/Theatre
